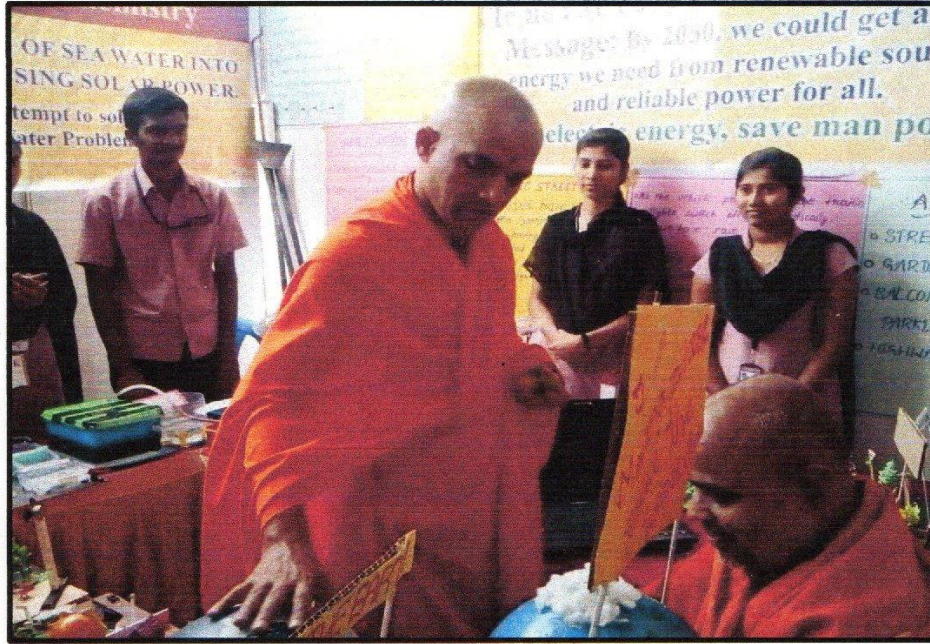

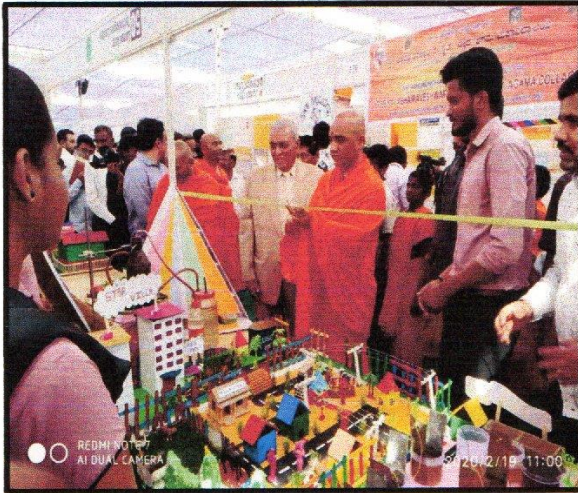
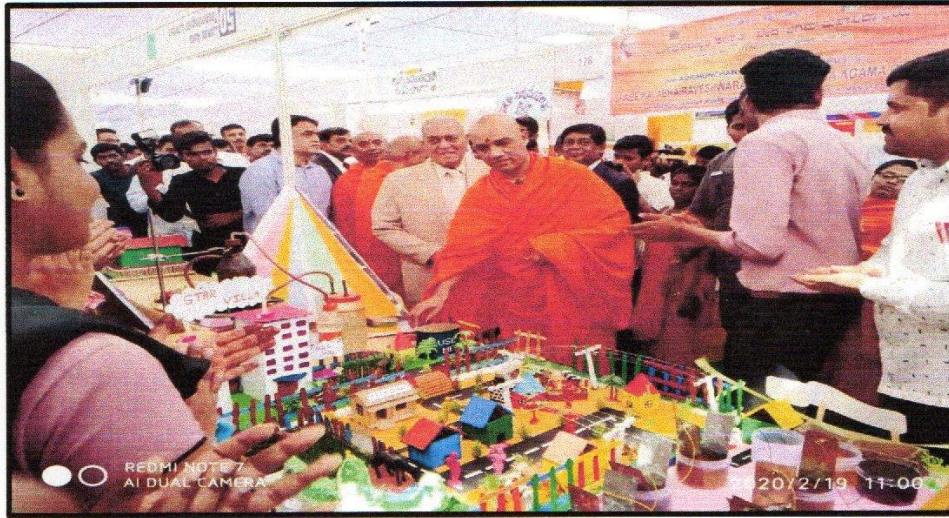
The programme was inaugurated by **Dr. H.C. Sharath Chandra Professor of IIS**. He was very impressed by the presentations and congratulated the participants.

We entered premises at 12:00 pm and spent more than 03 hours in the factory to see the production process of the factory.

Students were grouped into three batches and each group was guided by the BEML personnel. The guides explained manufacturing process of the factory i.e., materials used, product manufacture, marketability and profits etc.

BEML mainly manufactures heavy transport vehicle for defense and mining purpose vehicles. and also manufacture transport vehicle to carry the Missiles, war equipment's and water tanks. BEML not only manufacture vehicles for Governments, but also, for private people for mining purposes.

Our students have got sufficient exposure and clarified their doubts and got sufficient information about the factory by visiting different divisions of the factory i.e., assembling, plates cutting ,production of spare parts and stores departments etc.,. 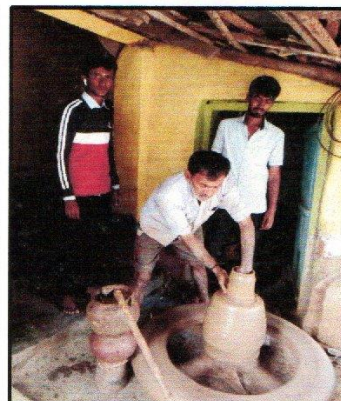
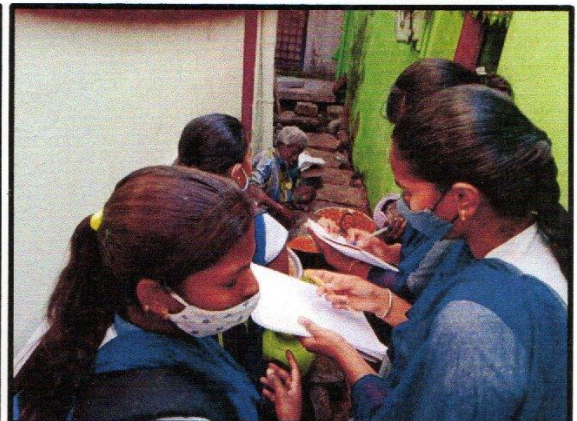
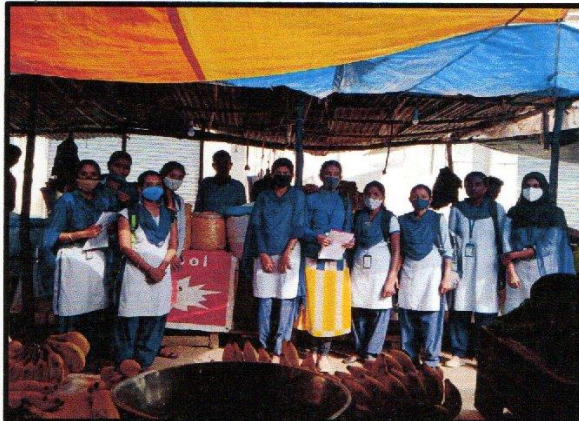
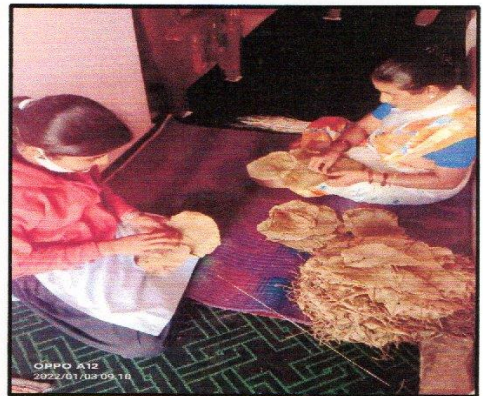
A Brief Report on Cottage Industry Visit

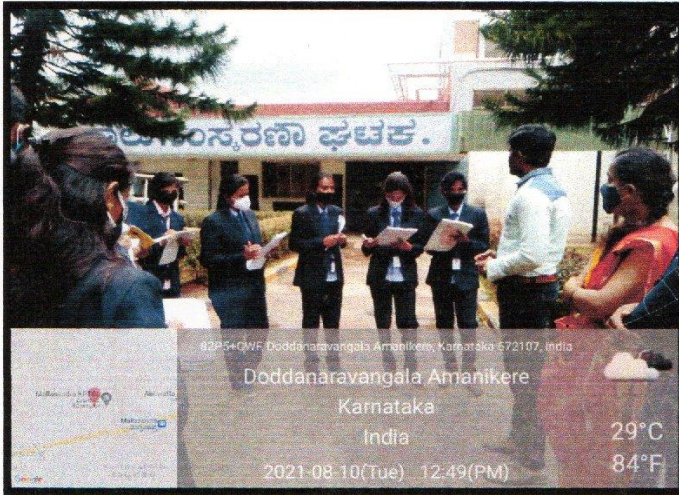
A Report on “Industrial Visit To Tumkur Co-operative Milk Producer’s Union Societies Limited”

On 10th August 2021, 13 students of First and Second Year M.com, along with 3 faculty members of Sri Adichunchanagiri College of Arts, Commerce and Science Nagamangala, visited Tumkur cooperative milk producers union societies limited (TUMUL) following the SOP of Covid-19. We all assembled at the college at 9:30 a.m. and left the college in a van. The team arrived at TUMUL by 11:45 am, after the completion of registration formalities. An engineer-in-charge of production received us at the entrance and gave a brief introduction to the factory. Mr. Girish took the responsibility of guiding the students.

The visit started with the production unit, the production manager explained about the different stages of production showing the plants where milk packaging is being done. Then he took us around from one section to the next and explained the process involved in milk production. The workers were doing the work concentrated. Everyone was wearing masks. He showed how milk is being pasteurized and being packaged maintaining hygiene, etc.

Then they took the students to different units of production like ‘peda production unit’ ‘ghee production unit’ etc. Afterwards, we entered the tetra pack plant, where a detailed explanation was given on how milk is being processed in order to increase its shelf life. There were two types of tetra packaged milk under production (Trupti and flexi pack) which is being supplied to the different states all over India.

Finally, the marketing manager elaborated on the multiple products introduced by the unit. The visit came to an end at 1:30 p.m. We left the premises at 1:45 p.m. It was an informative, interesting and a successful visit. As students and faculty of commerce, we learnt few things about the different departmental working and their coordination with each other in an industry. We express our thanks to the Principal who permitted us to go on the visit, the faculty members who accompanied us and the officials who explained the various departments.

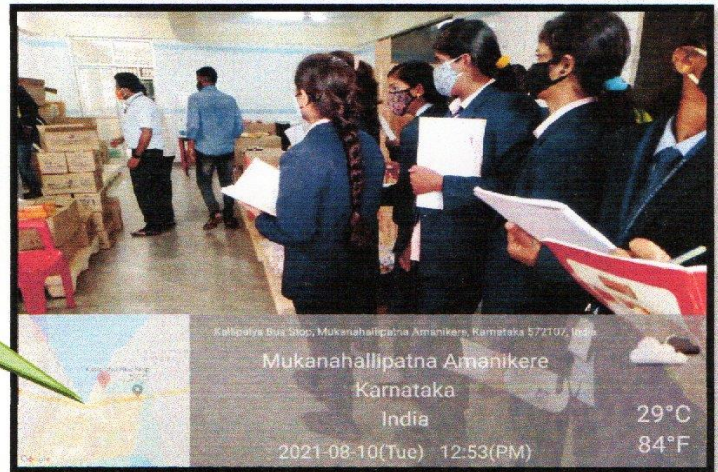

Report on “A Sociological Field Study of the Rural Market”

Department of sociology conduct “A Sociological Field Study of the Rural Market” on 11/12/2021. Sociology students of the final year visited the weekly market of Basaralu village. As per the guidelines of the university to organize a study trip for the students once in a year, in order to discuss the issues related to the Society. When we requested our Principal Dr. B .K. Lokesha for this Rural Market visit, he whole heartedly agreed and gave a nod for this visit. We left college premise at 10.30 a.m. a bus was organized by our department, for the visit. At 11.30 a.m., we visited Basaralu village market; the venders or merchants co-operated very well and gave the information regarding the market and venders.

The final year students divided into groups and each groups prepared a questionnaire for the vender and customers of the village. Our students collected the information from vendors for the purpose of their study tour, interviewing and observing vendors or traders, and understanding not only the socio-economic conditions of the vendor, but also the market background. By participating in the weekly saint, the students learned that the ‘market is a social institution. Gathered information on the problems customers face when purchasing items. Our students created awareness by collecting information and providing mask and sanitizer to venders and customers. The students learned about the difference between the past and present market system and gathered information about their lifestyle. 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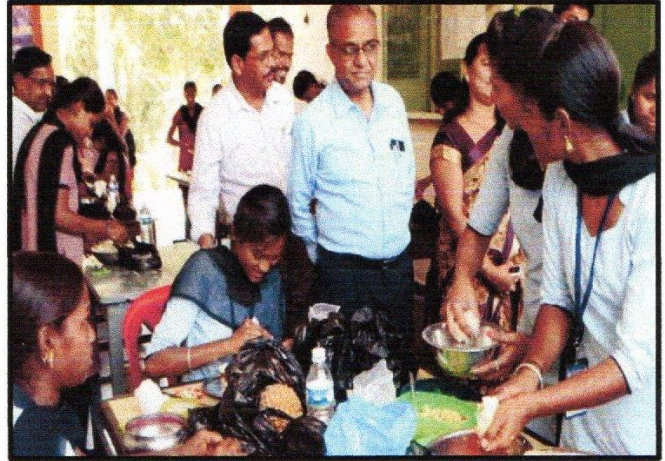
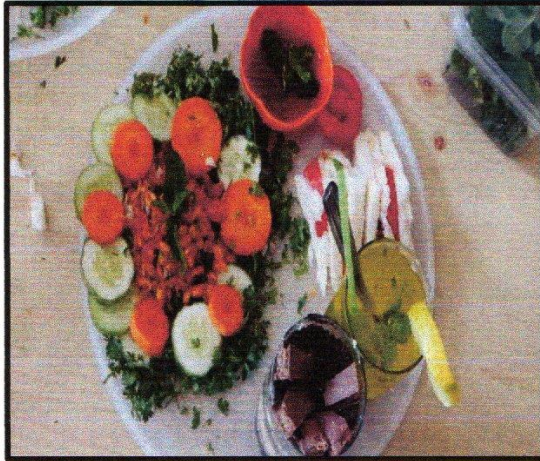
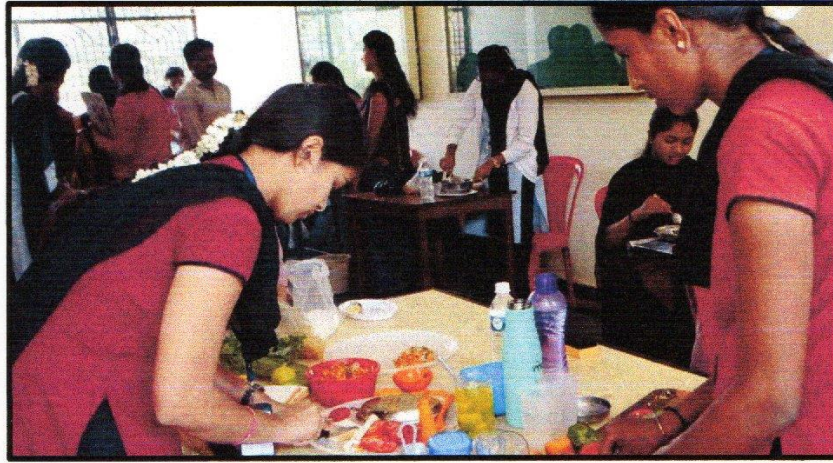
Cooking Without Fire Competition

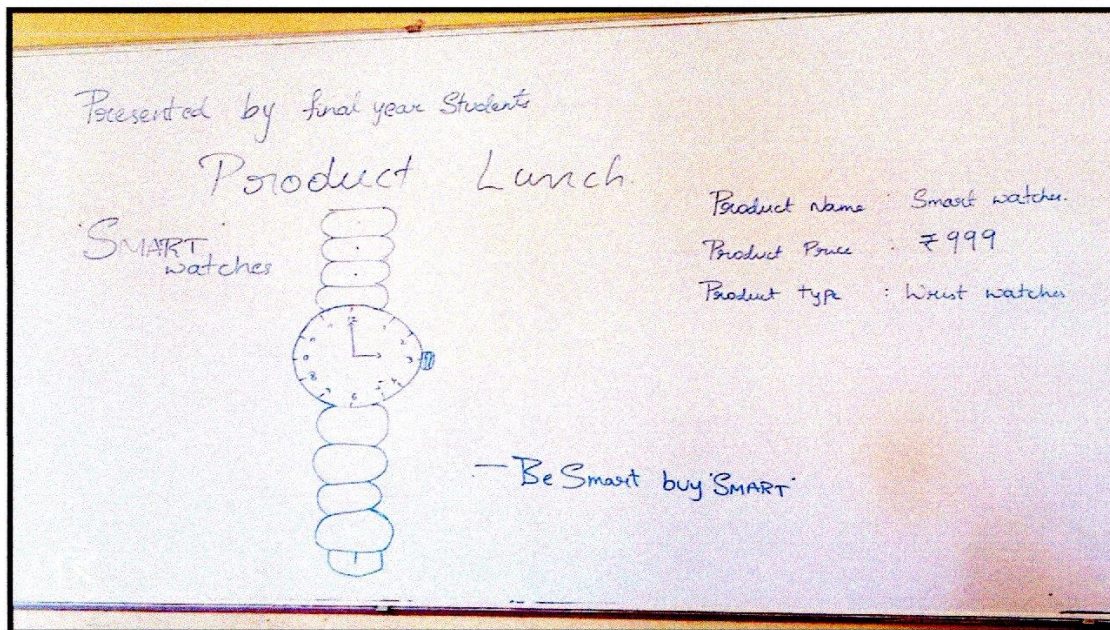

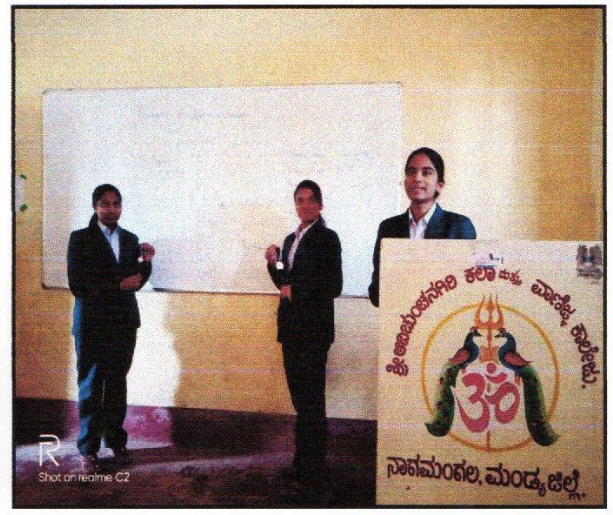
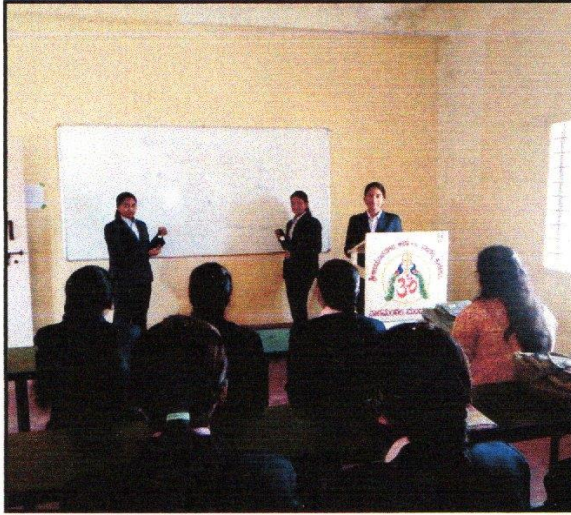
